This MSB obsoletes MCB-857

The following priority list shall be used as a guide to the scheduling of the 645 Development Machine. The sign-up system currently in effect will continue to be used; however, when necessary, people working on projects of lower priority may need to be rescheduled.

The priorities are as follows:

- 1. Repair of hardware or software problems that affect 645 Service performance or reliability.
- 2. Software development to complete Phase II of the Storage System Enhancements project.
- 3. Software development on the 645 that is required as part of the plan for 645F Multics but must be done on the 645.
- 4. Software or Hardware development to integrate the Bulk Store.
- 5. Software Development that is part of Storage System Enhancements Phase III, the "low cost" service project, or the the Tape software project.
- 6. All other projects.
