Stack Dumping in 64.5 Pseudo-processes <stack_dump>

Purpose

To dump the currently "good" part of the stack (i.e., frames which have not yet been returned from) during a 645 pseudo-process.

<u>Use</u>

At any point in a procedure when a stack dump is desired, issue a

"call stack_dump;"

This will cause a simple dump all of the stack below the stack-frame of <stack_dump> (i.e., there will be no breakdown into separate frames). <stack_dump>'s output goes to the error-file.

The attributes of <stack_dump> are SLVPRC, SLVACC.
