Purpose

The initializer is a 635 activity which performs the 635 initializing work necessary for the assembly and simulation system. The initializer opens the common error file and writes the name of the file as the first record. It opens and writes the name of the file to which the simulator may write the 645 core dump.

File Description

For tw1

The initializer reads control cards (34 word BCD) from the file IN. The control cards have the following format.

Word 0 Type indicator in the BCD form 00000t t defines the task the initializer is to perform. Presently, t=1 is the only recognized type. Word 1 and The 12 character name which word 2 is to be written as the first logical record on the file defined in word 3. The file code, left justified Word 3 of the file to be opened and identified.
