Find a Path Name for a Call Name

Purpose

The function search_for answers the question: "Where in the file system hierarchy would the Search Module (using the current search rules) find a segment for a given call name?" Search_for can be used to check out searching rules and as an immediate-value command.

<u>Usage</u>

(Note: call_name may be declared either char(*) varying or char (*).)

<u>Implementation</u>

The function search_for invokes the Search Module to find a path name for the call name call_name. search_for returns the path name as a varying character string; if no path name was found, search_for returns a zero length character string.
