## Purpose

This routine deletes a name from a specified entry.

### <u>Usage</u>

At command level:

delname <u>path</u>

As a subroutine:

call delname\_(path, code);

dcl path char(\*),

/\*path of entry name to be
deleted\*/

code fixed bin(17); /\*command system error code\*/

The entry name specified in <u>path</u> is deleted. The name must not be the only name for the entry. Write permission is necessary in the directory of the entry.

### Example

delname fred

The name "fred" is deleted from that entry in the working directory.

# <u>Implementation</u>

<u>setpath</u> is called to break the path into a directory and an entry. ufoSchname (BY.2.01) is called to perform the changes to the file system. If an error is detected it is reported by a call to command\_error.
